Key Themes

Meeting #10

The following topics were discussed at the meeting on 13 June 2024.

Mt Buller discussion points

- **Opening weekend** – Opening weekend and the Minister's visit was successful and positive feedback received
- **Transport systems** – Car park shuttles, village shuttle and rideshare all ran well, although numbers were lower than expected. Lots of positive feedback to the extended village shuttle running hours
- **Service charges** – Dialogue has taken place between ARV and a number of leaseholders about service charge increases
- **Stakeholder priorities** – Stakeholders presented list of priorities for ARV to work on. 70% already under way and 10% complete
- **Central village precinct master plan** – Discussed next steps and immediate priorities

ARV Discussion Points

- **Bushfire insurance** – Current leases allow for non-traditional insurance, but solutions need to be led by stakeholders
- **ARV Year in review and 2024 priorities** – Discussed Water Strategy, Visitor Services review, transport opportunities and staff accommodation.
- **Economic impact study** – key takeaways include Mt Buller being the highest visited resort, with an average spend of \$923 per winter visitor. Further details are available on the ARV website.
- **Service and service charge review** – Currently undertaking a service review and asset planning which will inform a service charge methodology review.
